<p>English</p> <p>In English, we will begin by writing our own story based on the text 'Stone Age Boy', using our history knowledge to focus on the setting for our story. We will write a non-chronological report about the Stone Age, using the text, 'The Secrets of Stonehenge' for support. We will also look at a range of poetry, fiction and non-fiction in guided reading.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In Maths, the year will begin with us all consolidating our place value knowledge. We will work on the four operations, this will continue throughout the term. Pupils will start with addition and subtraction, moving on to multiplication and division. The first half term will finish with measure - looking at time.</p>

<p>History/ Geography</p> <p>Throughout the half term History lessons, pupils will be exploring the big question - 'How did settlement change the way people lived in prehistoric Britain?' We will initially explore the time period 'The Stone Age' and explore the settlement of Early humans. We will explore the differences between the Stone Age and the Iron Age. We will also carry out an inquiry into the question, 'Is it important to learn about the past?'</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>This half term, the children will identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. We will also identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.</p>

<p>RE</p> <p>This RE, pupils will investigate in depth different religious and spiritual ways of life regarding diverse beliefs about God.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE, we will be exploring how our diet impacts us in our daily lives. We will gain a better understanding of how we can be healthy and who can help us with this.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>In Computing, we will be learning how to keep ourselves safe online. Pupils will revisit - click and start events in coding.</p>
