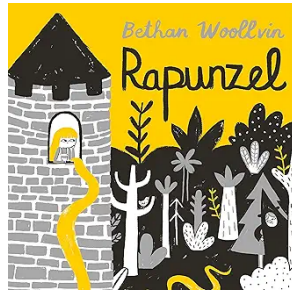

English

We will be exploring traditional tales. We are looking at Rapunzel. We will be writing traditional tale sentences, as well as trap sentences.



Maths

We will continue with our work on addition and subtraction within 10. We will be finding parts of a number and finding out how many are left, using cubes, counters and number lines to help us with our counting.

We will also be recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes.

History/Geography

We are going to continue learning about how houses have changed since the Victorian times, thinking about how they kept clean and what technology they had.

In Geography we will be exploring our local area. We will go on a local walk to find local features e.g. the zebra crossing.

Science

This half term we will be exploring seasons.

The children will go on an Autumn walk to find the features of Autumn e.g. pinecones, conkers and different coloured leaves.

RE

In RE, we will learn about Christianity and what Christians believe. We will find out about objects that are special to Christians and how they worship. In the Spring term we learn about Islam.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be exploring personal qualities, strategies to manage feelings, the impact of sleep on our wellbeing and the importance of keeping ourselves clean and safe (in the sun, allergies).

Computing

We will be learning about how to stay safe online and what to do if something makes us worry. We will talk about who our trusted adults are that we can talk to.

Art/DT

In art we will be exploring texture through printing, with a range of different materials. We will use houses as our inspiration, exploring the idea of repeating patterns and experimenting with different ways to do this.

PE

We will focus on developing the children's sending and returning skills. The children will learn how to play target games, working on their aiming skills.

PE kits should be worn to school on Tuesday (1SJ), Wednesday (1OC/1SJ) and Friday (1OC).
