English

This half term we will be immersing, analysing, planning and writing an exploration narrative and a formal mission log. We will continue to use 'No Nonsense Spelling' in our spelling sessions. We will be reading and responding to a variety of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts in our Shared Reading.

Maths

The children will continue to complete 'Flashback 4' tasks at 8.45 each morning. The children will continue to work on core knowledge in arithmetic for three sessions each week. The main lessons focus on two blocks. We will start with decimals, adding and subtracting decimals, understanding the place value of each digit. We will consolidate digit movement when multiplying and dividing by 10, 100, 1000. This will then fit nicely into the block of formal multiplication. Pupils must continue to learn their multiplication tables to 12, to be able to fully access the curriculum.

History/ Geography

We will start the term exploring what canals are and we will then look at why the Manchester Ship Canal was important in Victorian Manchester.

Science

This half term, children will focus on materials and their properties. The children will continue to develop skills in working scientifically.

RE

This half term we will learn about who Hindus are and what they believe in. There will also be workshops exploring aspects of Diwali, Interfaith week and Christmas.

PSHE

This half term will focus on learning about friends and relationships using our new 'Kapow' resources.

Computing

The half term will always begin with E-safety. This half term's focus is on 'Be Internet Alert', looking at how to be a critical consumer while online and about different online scams, including what 'phishing' means. Coding using 'Discovery Coding' will continue, looking at how computers use numbers to describe an object's properties e.g. speed.

<p>Art/ DT</p> <p>The children will be learning a very brief history of biscuits and then will explore different biscuit varieties and then engage with the design process in creating their own Victorian-style biscuits.</p>	<p>Spanish</p> <p>This half term's theme is 'Time in the city'. The children will review and build on what has been learned in Stage 2 about town places. They will learn about Madrid and practise language for buying tickets and asking for directions. The children will continue to develop their skills and understanding in the four areas of listening, speaking, reading and writing.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>During the term, children will focus on developing send and return skills through basketball and netball.</p> <p>Pupils will continue to build on team building skills, rules and point systems within the two sports.</p>
