English

In English, we will begin by looking at a range of descriptive features such as prepositions, adverbs, similes and expanded noun phrases. We will then be looking at the book 'The Rhythm of The Rain'. We will be looking at features of a setting description which will then support us to write our own version to describe a waterfall setting.

Maths

In Maths, we will begin the term by revising our work on multiplication and division and learning about how they are connected to each other. We will then move onto money; recognising the values and being able to calculate totals and change as well as learning which coins would be most appropriate to use for specific totals.

History/ Geography

This term, Year 3 will be exploring the big question 'What do we know about the ancient Egyptians from what has been left behind?' We will be looking at the artefacts and clues that have been left behind from the ancient Egyptians and discussing what they tell us about life in ancient Egypt.

Science

This half term, our topic is Light. We will be learning about where light comes from, the natural and man-made sources of light and how to stay safe in the sun.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring the question, 'Why are the Bible, Torah and Quran important?'. We will be looking at their purposes and use through their daily lives. Children will have a deeper understanding of why it is used in a certain way.

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will continue to be looking at health and wellbeing and moving onto Being safe which includes basic first aid and online safety.

Computing

This half term, we will be doing our usual e-safety lesson, then we will be completing our Multimedia unit which is 'Photography'.

Art/ DT

In Art we will be learning about drawing with different materials and looking at images which are special to Ancient Egyptians and why.

Spanish

This term in year 3, we will be learning about how to use Spanish when discussing; animals, their nouns and how to create sentences and stories.

PE

This term, the children will be introduced to a variety of new skills. The children will practice a variety of shapes and movements. In groups, the children will then plan, perform and repeat sequences of movements in a group.
