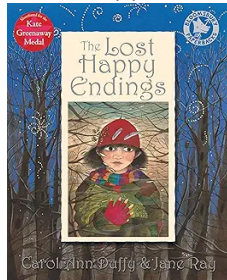

### English

This half term we will focus on narrative writing, and persuasive writing:

We will continue to focus on handwriting, spelling, punctuation and grammar.

### Maths

This half term we will be focusing on fractions, statistics and decimals, and apply our knowledge to a variety of mental maths.

We will have a big focus on our times-tables in preparation for the MTC in June. Children will have learnt their entire times-tables from 1-12

### History/ Geography

Our Theme topic this half term is 'Anglo-Saxons'.

We will be looking at areas such as the geographical location of Anglo-Saxon kingdoms, Anglo-Saxon religion, and the emergence of Christianity. We will also investigate how the Viking invasion impacted Anglo-Saxon Britain.

### Science

This half term we will focus on - animals and living things. We will construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey. We will look at feeding relationships in the food chains and what impacts them.

We will continue to focus on working scientifically when conducting investigations and research.

### RE

This term, our Big Question is 'How do people decide what is worth celebrating?' As part of our learning, we will explore what Christians do to celebrate at Easter, why Muslims celebrate at the end of Ramadan and why Jewish people celebrate Pesach every year.

### PSHE

This half term will focus on health and wellbeing as well as safety and the changing Body. Topics include internet safety, growing up, and how to manage our feelings.

### Computing

In computing this half term, we will continue to focus on learning about a variety of developing our coding skills using Discovery Coding. We will also be looking at aspects of .e-safety
