English

This half term, Year 5 will be continuing to read and analyse a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts during Shared Reading. The children will immerse themselves in and analyse, then plan and write a character narrative as well as a letter. The children will continue to develop their spellings through 'No Nonsense Spelling'.

Maths

This half term, children will be continuing to work on their multiplication & division skills, including multiplying 3 & 4 digit numbers by 2 digits; dividing with remainders and solving reasoning problems involving multiplication & division. We will also continue to develop children's fractions knowledge, including multiplying fractions by integers and finding fractions of amounts.

History/ Geography

This half term, the children will have a History focus during Theme lessons, delving into the questions 'Who were the Vikings', looking at aspects of Viking life including when and why they invaded Britain.

Science

This half term, Year 5 will focus on plants and animals. The children will be learning about parts of flowering plants. The children will learn about life cycles of plants and animals, including humans.

RE

This half term's big question is 'What is Humanism?'.

PSHE

Using the Kapow scheme of work, this half term will focus on exploring the emotional and physical changes of puberty, including menstruation; learning about online safety, influence, strategies to overcome potential dangers and how to administer first aid to someone who is bleeding.

Computing

The half term will always begin with E-safety. This half term's focus will further develop skills and understanding to enable the children to 'Be Internet Kind', practising empathy. The children will also continue to use Discovery Coding to practice and develop skills in areas such as setting values, using coordinates, friction codes, generating random numbers and looking at how these can be used in simulations.

The children will revise and extend some clothing vocabulary. They will use adjectives to describe clothes and will learn some vocabulary associated with carnival outfits.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>During the half term, children will focus on developing creative movement skills through Dance.</p>
<p>Music</p> <p>This half term, the children will continue to build upon their understanding of simple rhythms and notation covered so far during this year.
