Maths

This half term we are focusing on place addition and subtraction up to 20. We will be exploring number bonds, doubles and counting back using a range of manipulatives to help us. We will also be focusing on place value, we will be counting from 20-50 and counting in 10's. Some of us will focus on numbers 1-5 and exploring this in different ways.

Key experiences

To support our understanding of key learning linked to our book 'Where the wild things are' and seasons we will also have some key experiences. We will be going on a nature walk around the school grounds to look for Spring changes, we will also be accessing the forest school area to explore and make dens. We will celebrate World Book Day and we can dress up as our favourite character and we will be having an outdoor picnic and baking biscuits linked to our key book.



History/Geography

This term we will be thinking about people who help us and specifically nurses. We will be looking at images from past and present and what we know is the same and what is different in hospitals. We will look at some key historical figures like Florence Nightingale and think about what she did to help others

Science

This half term we will be learning about seasonal changes, focusing on the changes from Winter to Spring. We will be describing the features of Spring and going on nature walks to see the changes on our school grounds and surrounding area. We will begin to look at the weather daily and display it in our classroom.

RE

In RE, we will begin to learn about Islam. We will find out what the Qu'ran is and look at
