English

This half term we will be focusing on the text *The Journey*. Detail the journey of a refugee family. We will be writing a refugee narrative along with various poems, setting and character descriptions.



Maths

This half term we will be focusing on number and place value, the four operations, fractions, decimals and percentages as well as position and direction in our Geometry work.

Our main focus will be securing the children's understanding of decimals and dividing by 10 and 100

We will have a big focus on our times-tables in preparation for the MTC in June.

History/ Geography

Our Theme topic this half term is 'Early Islamic Civilisation'. Our 'Big Question' will be 'What did Baghdad and the Caliphate do for us?'

Science

This half term we will focus on Animals and humans. How the digestive system works, and how our teeth work.

We will visit a farm to further explore life cycles and biological processes.

RE

This term, children will be exploring two 'Big Questions': 'Why do some people think life is a journey?' and 'What significant experiences mark this?'

PSHE

This half term will focus on citizenship. Universal human rights, and the responsibilities of citizens.

Computing

In Computing this half term, we will focus on developing our skills in creating data handling projects. We will be using Google Sheets to facilitate this. Our unit, as always, will begin with an E-safety focus.
