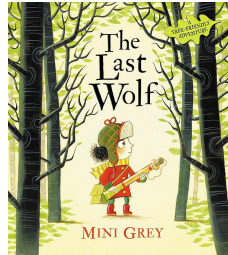
Succeed Together

English

We will be exploring the book 'The Last Wolf' by Mini Grey to write a narrative and a recipe.

We will be using phonics strategies to write sentences and learn to write Y1 grammar features e.g. past tense verbs, using 'and' to join sentences, capital letters at the start of a sentence and for names and using fullstops.

We will also practice spelling the days of the week correctly.



Maths

This half term we will begin learning about positional language and directions e.g. full turn, half turn and quarter turns.

We will be learning about the place value of numbers up to 100 and practice counting forwards and backwards from 100.

We will also be learning about money and time.

History/Geography

In Geography, we are continuing to explore the countries that make up the UK. We will learn the countries of the UK, where they are on a map and what their physical features are. We will also be learning the names of the capital cities and surrounding seas.

Science

This half term we will continue to learn about plants. We will be focusing on the conditions plants need for growth. We will also be looking at how our local environment changes in the Summer time.

RE

In RE, we will continue to learn about Christianity and Islam. We will learn about what similarities there may be and what places are sacred to Christians and Muslims.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be talking about our feelings using the Zones of Regulation. We will be taking part in transition activities to prepare for the change of moving to Year 2.

Computing

In Computing, we are starting Discovery Coding. We will learn how to code by using precise instructions, combining start and input events to create fun games.

Art/DI

In Art we are going to explore more artwork created by David Hockney. We will be focusing on landscapes, experimenting with shape and colour mixing. We will then paint our own landscape for our final piece.

PE

The children will be practicing their athletic skills to help prepare them for taking part in Sports Day (Wednesday 10th June 9:15-11:30)
