<p>English</p> <p>This half term we will be focusing on the text Manfish. A story about Jacques Cousteau's life. There will be a variety of writing outcomes from narratives, short poems, and exploring non-fiction resources.</p> 		<p>Maths</p> <p>This half term we will be focusing on money (using the 4 operations), shape, and time.</p> <p>Our main arithmetic focus will be securing the children's understanding of equivalent fractions, and converting better improper fractions and mixed numbers.</p> <p>We will have a big focus in the first two weeks back after half-term in practicing and completing our MTC assessments.</p>		
<p>History/ Geography</p> <p>Continuing our Theme topic this half term 'Early Islamic Civilisation'. Our 'Big Question' will be 'What is the geography of Bagdad?'</p>		<p>Science</p> <p>This half term we will explore the basics of electricity. We will identify household appliances, build simple circuits and test which materials are electrical conductors or insulators. We will also learn how to stay safe around electricity and power sources, We will be focusing on working scientifically, and using correct vocabulary.</p>		
<p>RE</p> <p>This half term, we will be asking the big question 'What can we learn from religions about deciding what is right or wrong?'</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>This half term, we will be focusing on citizenship, economic well being, Learning about the value of money, earning money, and looking after our money.</p>		<p>Computing</p> <p>In Computing this half term, we will focus on developing our skills in creating data handling projects We will be using Google Sheets to facilitate this.</p> <p>Our unit, as always, will begin with an E-safety focus on privacy and sharing.</p>	
<p>Art/DT</p> <p>The children will be using research to develop specific design criteria that will help them create a plush toy using socks.</p>	<p>Spanish</p> <p>In Spanish, we will be completing the unit: Let's Celebrate!
