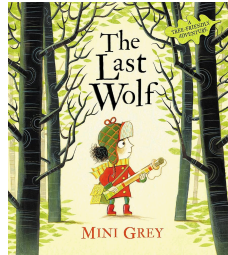

English

We will be exploring the book 'The Last Wolf' by Mini Grey to write a narrative and a recipe.

We will be exploring a scheme called 'Drawing Club' to support our mark making, writing and imagination skills. We will be using our phonics knowledge to say and write initial sounds, words and sentences using these grammar features: full stops, capital letters.



Maths

This half term we will begin learning about number lines to 50, one more and one less. Some of us will continue to focus on numbers 1-5 and exploring this in different ways with a range of resources and opportunities. We will then move on to exploring lengths and heights and make comparison. We will explore heavy and light and move on to mass. We will finish our maths learning for the term with full, empty and capacity,

History/Geography

In Geography, we are continuing to explore the countries that make up the UK. We will learn the countries of the UK, where they are on a map and what their physical features are. We will also be learning the names of some capital cities and surrounding seas.

Science

This half term we will be exploring and learning about plants. We will be focusing on the conditions plants need for growth, and have a go at growing some seeds so that we can notice changes and growth. We will also be looking at how our local environment changes in the Summer time.

RE

In RE, we will continue to learn about Christianity and Islam. We will learn about what similarities there may be and what places are sacred to Christians and Muslims.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about building relationships focusing on our families and friends. We will explore festivals, sharing, thinking about what makes a good friend and teamwork

Computing

In Computing, we are starting Discovery Coding. We will learn how to code by using precise instructions, combining start and input events to create fun games. Some of us will work independently and some of us will be supported
