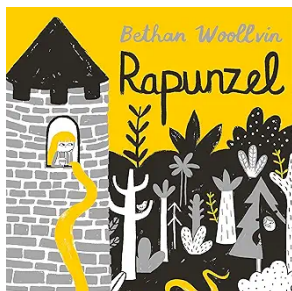

English

We will be exploring traditional tales. We are looking at Rapunzel. We will be using our phonics to write simple sentences, using neat letter formation.



Maths

In Maths, we will be exploring place value, learning about the value of numbers up to 10. We will then learn how to add and subtract numbers to 10.

Key vocabulary: one more, one less, ten, ones, add, subtract, altogether, total

History/Geography

In History, we will be learning about what it was like to live in the Victorian times and how homes have changed over time, including how we keep clean and the toys we play with.

We will be visiting Elizabeth Gaskell's House to explore real life Victorian objects.

Science

In Science, we will be focusing on everyday materials. We will be learning the names of different materials and naming what material a range of objects are made from.

We will explore their properties e.g. hard, soft, waterproof and transparent. We will also be sorting objects in different ways, including into man-made and natural objects.

RE

In RE, we will learn about Christianity and what Christians believe.

In the Spring term we will learn about Islam.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be introducing the Zones of Regulation to the children and talking about managing feelings. We will be learning strategies for self regulation too.

Computing

In Computing, we will learn about the different parts of a computer and their function. We will also be learning about who our trusted adults are to keep us safe online.

Art/DT

In DT, we will be learning about freestanding structures and designing our own freestanding dolls house. We will need cardboard boxes so it would be great if you could save some for us - we will send more information on Dojo.

PE

This term the children will be learning the skills needed for attack and defence games.
