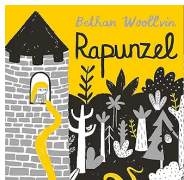
Succeed Together

Theme: Hot and Cold Places

Our topic this term is Hot and Cold Places. Children will be learning what it is like in hot and cold places and which animals we might find there through continuous provision. We will be exploring photographs, using a range of resources and learning new vocabulary. We will also be using a range of texts to support our learning.

English

We will be exploring traditional tales. We are looking at Rapunzel. We will be using our phonics to write simple sentences, using neat letter formation.



We will be using Little Wandle Foundations for rhyme time and to tune into sounds.

Maths

In Maths, we will be exploring place value, learning about the value of numbers up to 10. We will then learn how to add and subtract numbers to 10.

Our continuous provision activities will be linked to number and place value to support our learning.

PE

We will be having weekly PE sessions with our PE coach to support balance and co-ordination.

PSHE

This half term our PSHE topic will be relationships. We will look at how adults at school can help, and how to be a good friend.

Science

Our science topic is animals including humans. We will look at animals in hot and cold spaces.

Art/ DT

We will be using different skills to create self-portraits in our art lesson this year.

Music

Children will be accessing their year group music lessons and singing lessons this half term. We will also use our music station to make sounds linked to our weekly rhymes.

We will access sensory circuits daily to support movement breaks, self-regulation and prepare us for learning

We will receive daily intensive interactions 1:1 and Wellcomm screening with follow up activities to support understanding and use of language. We will use new vocabulary and words linked to the stories and experience we have throughout the half term. Children will also be accessing their year group classes.
